In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I have the honour to enclose herewith a copy of letter dated 16/07/2021 under reference as received from the Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India regarding National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMSS) which is an on-board scheme on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) since the year 2016-17.

The qualified candidates of the National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship (NMMS) Examination will have to apply on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) to get the scholarship amount. After completing the students' registration, the Heads of the Institutions have to verify the applications at the same portal by using Institute Login ID. Finally, the District Level Nodal Officers have to approve the verified applications by using the District Login ID at the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). Once the process is completed, the scholarship amount will be disbursed to the beneficiaries' account through DBT mode by the Govt. of India.

In the same way, Post-Metric Scholarship for SC Students sponsored by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, ST Scholarship, OBC Scholarship, Minority Scholarship etc. are also run under the National Scholarship Portal (NSP).

To make the process fast, mobilized for streaming & transparency, for increasing reliability of the process, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeiTY) has decided to implement Aadhaar based KYC as per the Direction of DBT Mission, Cabinet Secretariat for the Institution/District/State Nodal Officers (INO/DNO/SNO).

You are therefore, requested kindly to complete the District Nodal Officer (DNO) Aadhaar Verification at National Scholarship Portal (NSP) at the earliest.


Further, you are also requested kindly to instruct all the Institute Nodal Officers (INO) i.e. the head of the institutions under your jurisdiction to complete Aadhaar Verification at the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) within 15 days from the issue of the letter.
